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2025–2026 Wheat Crop Overview

At the time of writing this report, 2026 Oklahoma wheat production is estimated at approximately 64 million bushels, roughly 40% lower than both the 2025 and 2024 crops and about 32% below the previous 10-year average (Table 1). The decline is a direct reflection of a season dominated by persistent, severe drought. Approximately 4.6 million acres were planted for the 2026 crop, about 6% more than the previous year and near the 10-year average, but harvested area is estimated at just 2.3 million acres, as drought forced many producers to graze out, bale, or abandon fields that were not worth taking to grain. The statewide average yield is projected at 28 bu/ac, 10 bushels below the 2025 average and 4 bushels below the previous 10-year average.

Oklahoma's 2026 wheat crop was shaped by severe and persistent drought. Early September brought favorable moisture, and dual-purpose and graze-out producers took advantage of it, planting early to establish forage. Warm temperatures through September and into mid-October promoted rapid early growth, and the wheat that emerged generally looked good. Fall armyworms became severe in mid-September, and many producers were forced to treat emerging stands; a second flush moved through northwestern, western, and southwestern Oklahoma in October, prompting additional applications.

By mid-October, much of the state had turned dry and warm, and rainfall was scarce. With moisture lacking, many producers chose to dust in wheat intended for grazing, while holding grain-only acres back to wait for rain. Planting reached roughly 70% complete statewide by mid-October, the majority of it dusted in. A widespread rain at the end of October allowed most producers to finish planting and activated previously dusted-in seed. Southwestern Oklahoma, particularly around Altus, largely missed these rains and remained critically dry; planting there was delayed into late November.

Winter brought little relief. Rainfall remained limited and temperatures averaged above normal, and the combination accelerated development across the state.

By midwinter the crop was running roughly two weeks ahead of a typical calendar, and First Hollow Stem arrived correspondingly early, compressing grazing-termination decisions for dual-purpose producers. By February, crop condition had diverged sharply: fields planted into moisture and drawing on stored subsoil water looked good, while those without that reserve were already showing severe drought stress. Importantly, much of the apparently healthy wheat was sustained not by in-season rainfall but by stored soil moisture, leaving even the better fields increasingly dependent on a timely spring rain.

A freeze on March 16–17 coincided with much of the crop at or near jointing. Because development was generally lagging and the crop had not advanced to the more freeze-sensitive flowering stage, injury was limited and did not appear to reduce yield potential. Insect pressure shifted as temperatures warmed, with greenbugs and brown wheat mites reported, particularly in the southwest. Brown wheat mites, which thrive under hot, dry conditions, added stress to an already weakened crop, though many producers declined to treat to limit input costs on drought-stressed acres. By late March, conditions in southwestern Oklahoma had deteriorated to the point that numerous fields were adjusted by crop insurance, and some producers questioned whether the remaining stand was even worth baling. The fields that still looked somewhat good, needed rain to hold.

The critical turn came in the first week of April, when most of the state, excluding the northwest and Panhandle, received at least a quarter inch of rain. Modest as it was in some areas, the timing was decisive, and for many fields this proved the saving rain that carried the crop forward. Warm temperatures persisted afterward, followed by a beneficial cooldown in May that eased heat stress during grain filling. Even so, roughly 80% of Oklahoma remained in drought into early June, underscoring that these rains rescued the crop without reversing the season's moisture deficit.

Harvest began early, consistent with a crop that spent the entire season ahead of schedule, and dry conditions allowed it to advance quickly, with a few showers holding us back for a few days. Yields varied dramatically from field to field, reflecting differences in planting date, stored soil moisture, and the spotty distribution of the April rains, but the statewide picture was clearly below average. Where fields caught timely moisture, results were reasonable; elsewhere, many acres were grazed out, bailed, or abandoned rather than taken to grain. Ultimately, the 2026 crop stands as a reflection of a severe drought year—one in which wheat was carried largely on stored soil moisture and a few well-timed rains, under persistently warm temperatures and with little margin throughout.

Disease Overview

During the 2026 wheat growing season, viral diseases were the most widespread and economically damaging issues across Oklahoma. The wheat streak mosaic complex, caused by wheat streak mosaic virus (WSMV),

Triticum mosaic virus (TriMV), and High Plains wheat mosaic virus (HPWMoV), was prevalent across all major wheat-producing regions, not just the panhandle. This marks the second consecutive year of elevated pressure from this disease statewide.

Symptoms associated with wheat streak mosaic complex were first observed in early March and persisted throughout the spring. Although symptoms were obvious in spring, infections most likely took place in the fall, resulting in higher crop damage in comparison to spring infection. Warm temperatures during fall 2025 likely contributed to increased populations of the wheat curl mite, the vector responsible for transmitting these viruses. Among the three viruses, WSMV and TriMV were the most common, and co-infections of these two viruses were frequently observed. These mixed infections lead to intensified disease severity and yield losses. While HPWMoV was confirmed in multiple samples, its incidence remained lower relative to WSMV and TriMV.

Barley yellow dwarf (BYD) was also identified across the state, with first observations occurring in March at moderate to high levels in some fields. BYD virus is transmitted by cereal aphids, and similar to the wheat curl mite situation, warm fall temperatures likely allowed aphid populations to persist and spread the virus more effectively.

Fungal foliar diseases were present but generally less impactful in 2026 compared to viral diseases. Stripe rust and leaf rust were both detected starting in late March, but the incidence and severity of stripe rust remained low. Dry conditions limited stripe rust development, which is typically favored by cool and wet weather. Leaf rust, however, continued to progress despite drought conditions. Even so, the overall impact of leaf rust on yield should not be high in most fields, as leaf rust pressure peaked when much of the wheat had already progressed well beyond the early stages of kernel development, reducing the potential for significant yield loss.

As the crop approached heading, dryland root rots became more noticeable, particularly in fields severely affected by drought. Common root rot and Fusarium crown and root rots have been a recurring issue across Oklahoma for the past five seasons, largely driven by persistent drought conditions, which favor their development.

As wheat harvest progressed across Oklahoma, reports emerged of loose smut-contaminated grain being received at elevators in central Oklahoma. Grain from infected plants does not pose a problem when used for milling; however, grain harvested from fields infested with loose smut is not recommended for use as seed in subsequent seasons.

Overall, the 2025–2026 wheat season was marked by severe drought, warm temperatures, and one of the most widespread outbreaks of viral diseases in recent Oklahoma history. Despite above-average planted acreage, moisture deficits throughout the growing season substantially reduced harvested acres and yield potential.



Testing Methods and Data Interpretation

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Testing Methods

Seed was packaged and planted in the same condition as delivered from the respective seed companies. Most seed was treated with an insecticide plus a fungicide, but the formulation and rate of seed treatment used was not confirmed or reported in this document.

Plots were seven rows wide with 7.5-inch row spacing and were sown with a Great Plains no-till drill modified for cone-seeded, small-plot research. Plots were planted 25 feet long and trimmed to 19 feet at harvest with the plot combine. Wheel tracks were included in the plot area for yield calculation for a total plot width of 60 inches. The experimental design for all sites was a randomized complete block with four replicates. The intensive management trials at Apache, Chickasha, and Lahoma received two fungicide applications, additional topdress nitrogen application in the spring, and were planted on a seeds per acre basis at 1.2 million seeds per acre. Fungicide was applied at Feekes 6 (jointing) and Feekes 9 (flag leaf completely emerged). Additional information on product name, rate and date of application is included in the tables for the respective sites.

Plots received 5 gal/ac of 10-34-0 at planting. All variety trial locations were sown at 60 pounds per acre, except for the dual-purpose trials at El Reno and Walters, which were sown at 120 pounds per acre and the Panhandle trials at Balko and Hooker, which were sown at 45 pounds per acre. Grazing intensity, nitrogen fertilization, and insect and weed control decisions were made on a location-by-location basis and reflect standard management practices for the area. In general, the spring-applied N rate was calculated for a 70 bu/ac yield goal for the standard management trials and 100

bu/ac yield goal for the intensive management trials.

Plots were harvested with a Winterstieger Delta small plot combine. Grain weight, test weight, protein concentration, and moisture content were collected from each plot, and grain yields and protein concentration were corrected to 12% moisture content. Grain moisture at all sites was generally below 12%, and maximum and minimum grain moisture for all plots at a location typically ranged no more than 2%.

Data Interpretation

Yield, test weight, and protein data for each location and regional summary were analyzed using the appropriate statistical methods. At the bottom of each table, the mean and least significant difference (LSD) values are reported. The LSD is a test statistic that aids in determining whether there is a true difference in yield, test weight, and protein. In this report, one can be 95% confident that the difference between two varieties is real if the difference is greater than the LSD value. Data that is not significantly different is indicated by "NS". For example, if the LSD value is 4 bu/ac in a trial where Variety A yielded 30 bu/ac and Variety B yielded 25, then Variety A would be considered to have a statistically higher yield. However, if Variety C yielded 27 bu/ac, then Variety A and Variety C would be considered to have a similar yield. In that same example trial, there is a 5% chance that the 4 bu/ac difference between Variety A and Variety B does not truly exist, but random chance caused the 5 bushel difference. These chance factors may include differences in fertility, moisture availability, and diseases. To aid in visualizing the varieties with the highest yields, test weights, and proteins, values highlighted in gray do not differ statistically from the highest value within a column. The performance of a

variety may vary from year to year, even at the same location. Tests over two or more years and over multiple locations more accurately predict the performance of a variety.

Note:

The dryland variety trials at Balko and Hooker in the Oklahoma Panhandle were harvested this season; however, yield results from these locations will not be published. Severe drought resulted in extremely low yields and substantial field variability, leading to coefficients of variation (CV) greater than 50% in both trials. At this level of variability, the experiments did not provide the precision necessary for reliable comparisons among varieties, and observed yield differences are more likely attributable to field variability than to genetic performance. Because the Oklahoma Wheat Variety Trials are intended to provide producers with accurate, research-based information for variety selection, we do not publish results that fail to meet our quality standards. 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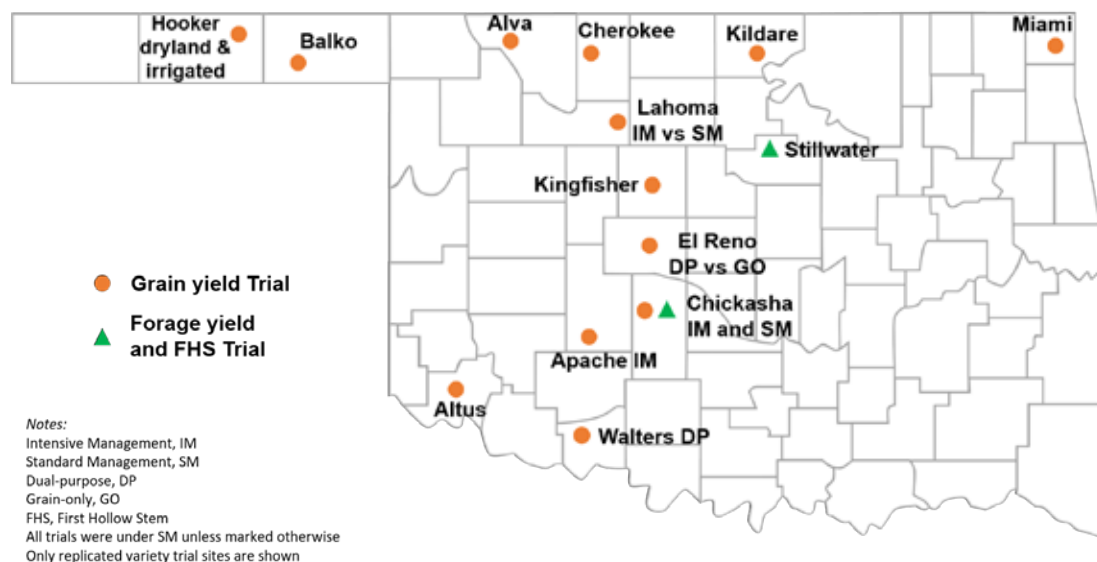


Figure 1. Performance Test Locations

Double-dashes "--" = data not available. The Altus trial experienced severe drought stress throughout the season, with no rainfall events exceeding 0.25 inches until early February (0.72 inches) and 1.75 inches received during the first week of April. The resulting short, thin stand exhibited patterns of environmental variation across the field that could not be removed with our experimental design, resulting in an inflated CV of 25%. This inflated CV indicates reduced experimental precision; therefore,

SEED SAMPLING AND TESTING

No matter how accurate the seed analysis, it reveals only the quality of the sample submitted. It is important, therefore, that certain procedures be followed in collecting seed samples for testing purposes which most nearly represent the bulk of the seed in a given lot.

A. General procedures:

1. Take equal portions from evenly distributed parts of the quantity of seed to be sampled.
2. For free-flowing seeds, use a probe or trier long enough to sample all portions whether seed is in bags or bulk.
3. For non-free-flowing seed, such as chaffy seeded grasses, thrust the hand into the bulk and withdraw representative portions.

B. Obtaining a representative sample for laboratory analysis:

1. When more than one core or handful is drawn, follow different paths.
2. For lots of one to six bags, obtain a sample from each bag.
3. For lots of more than six bags, sample five bags plus at least 10% of the number of bags in the lot. Regardless of the lot size, it is not necessary to sample more than 30 bags. For example, seed lots consisting of 7, 100 and 400 bags, each would require 6, 15, and 30 bags to be sampled, respectively. For bulk seed, a composite sample may be obtained by taking many cores or handfuls as if the same quantity of seed were in bags of an ordinary size. Take samples from well distributed points throughout the bulk.
4. For samples taken during cleaning/conditioning sub samples should be taken periodically from the clean seed stream and combined to form a composite sample.

SUBMITTING SEED SAMPLES

All certified seed must be cleaned by the grower or by an Approved Conditioner and a representative sample of each cleaned lot of seed must be submitted to the OCIA Designated Laboratory for analysis. If seed is to be treated prior to marketing, both treated and untreated samples must be submitted. The treated sample must be labeled "TREATED" and must show the kind of chemical treatment used.

SEED SAMPLE LABELING REQUIREMENTS

Form C "Request for Testing and Certificate of Inspection" must be sent to the OCIA office for all samples submitted for testing.

SIZE OF SEED SAMPLES

Weeping lovegrass, bluestem, bermudagrass, other grass seed. ½ pound

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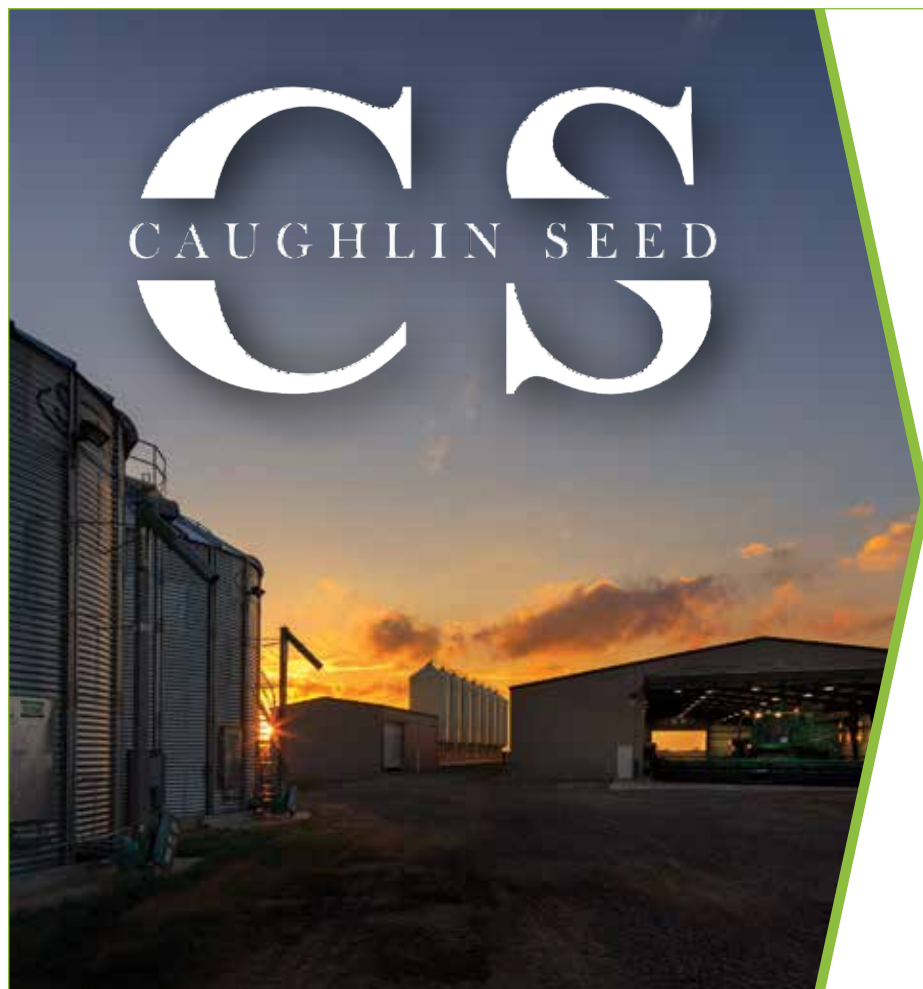

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How Can I Become A Certified Seed Grower?

Seed Certification is open to all who wish to participate. Seed Certification is the process required to produce high quality pedigreed seed. It is in effect the same type of system that the major seed companies use to ensure that the grain producer is getting high quality seed.

Certified seed is a limited generation seed production system. Each time that you produce a class of certified seed you start with fresh clean seed. This process insures that problems with varietal purity, weed and other crop seed will be a limited factor. Foundation seed produces Registered seed, Registered seed produces Certified seed and Certified seed produces grain.

There are several basic requirements to become a certified seed producer. First you need to buy eligible seed. If you are going to produce Certified seed you will need to purchase Registered seed. This seed needs to be planted on clean ground, ground that has not produced a like crop in the past year or has been planted to the same variety of certified seed in the past year. For example, if you are going to produce Certified Duster you will need to purchase Registered Duster and plant it on ground that was not in wheat the previous year or was planted with Certified seed to produce grain. This insures that there will be no contamination by other varieties of wheat.

After you have selected the variety and have selected clean ground you will need to submit an application to the OCIA office. Applications are

now submitted online. You will need to contact the OCIA office for complete instructions. Next you will need to prepare your field for inspection by OCIA. This involves removing any impurities such as rye which may have been spread by birds or fertilizer applications and controlling any noxious weeds such as field bindweed. Isolation also needs to be determined at this time. In wheat there needs to be 10 feet between a certified seed field and other wheat. This area may be a ditch, fence row or it can be harvested for grain and taken to the elevator.

Next field inspection will occur, the inspector will contact you prior to harvest to make you aware that he will be in the area and that your field is ready for inspection. After inspection is completed you will receive a copy of the field inspection report.

DO NOT harvest your field before you have been notified that your field has been inspected and has been approved for certification. Check your myFields account for

the status of your field inspection and review the inspector's report. If you have not been notified by the inspector or your field is still listed as "pending" on myFields, call the OCIA office immediately before cutting. Fields that have been harvested prior to inspection are **NOT** eligible for certification.

This is followed by seed conditioning. Seed conditioning removes broken seed and chaff along with any weed seed that may be present. This can

either be done by an approved conditioner listed in the directory or with your own seed cleaning equipment.

After cleaning has been completed or in process a sample of seed will need to be sent for testing. This will provide you with all the necessary information for the label requirements and ensure that the seed meets OCIA standards. At this point if everything has met standards you have completed certification. You will need to order tags for either bags or to be used with bulk sales.

Before the seed is sold you will need to purchase a seed dealer's license from Oklahoma Department of Agriculture.

Interested in Becoming a Bulk Retail Facility?

Becoming a Bulk Retail Facility allows you to sell Certified Seed in bulk, providing your customers with a readily available source of high quality seed. If you or your company is interested in becoming a bulk seed retail facility you will need to contact OCIA. Such a facility may be part of a seed conditioning plant or the facility may be approved for handling bulk seed only. This will require that you fill out an Approved Bulk Retail application and have an inspection completed before selling Certified Seed in bulk.

You will need to provide your customers with a Seed Sales Acknowledgement with appropriate seed label affixed to the front of the form (PVP)

Certified Seed Labels **must** be purchased from OCIA. This allows your facility to sell certified seed that has been purchased from certified seed growers. It also ensures that your customers are getting the appropriate variety as a class of certified seed.

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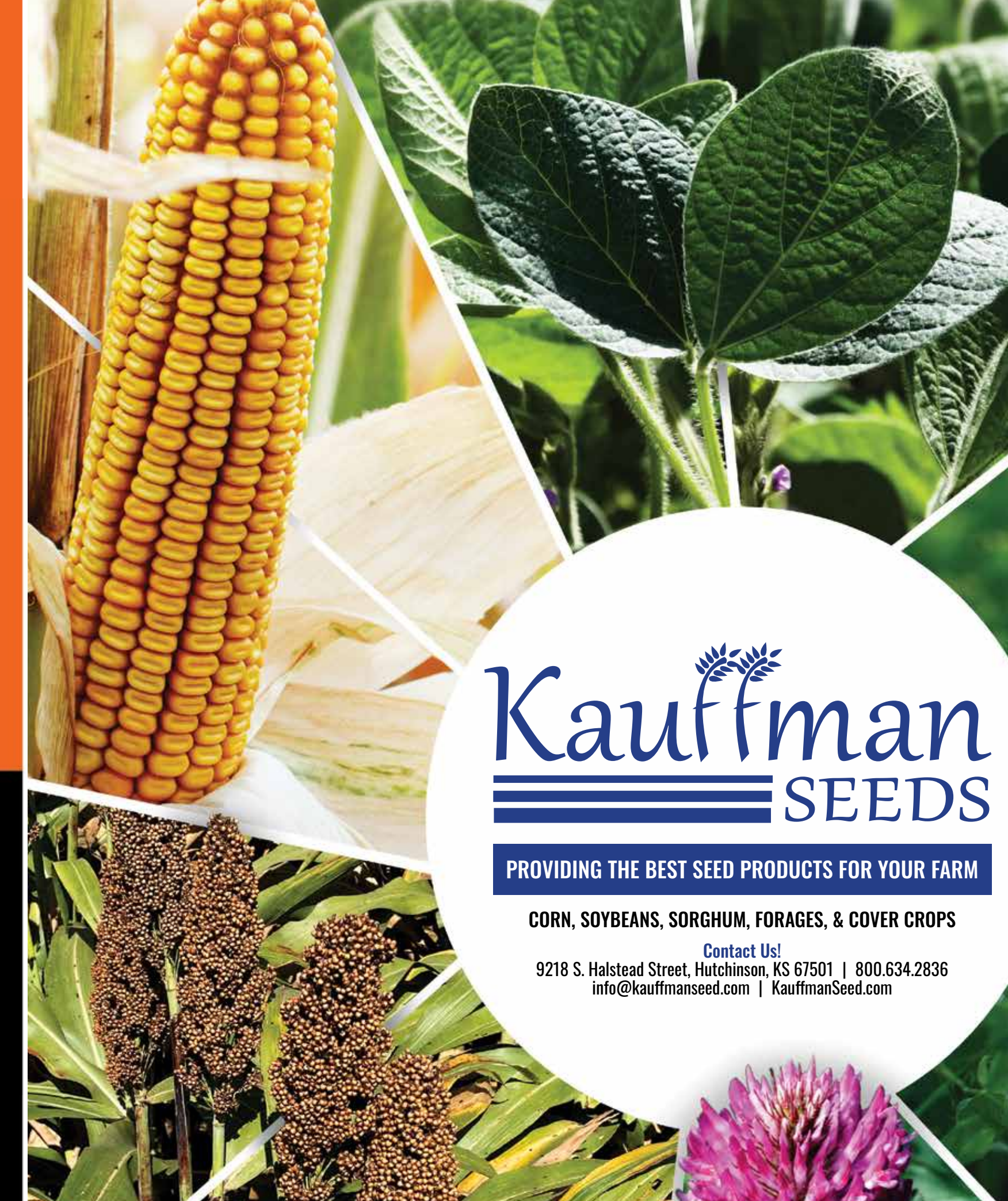
